Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the safe, efficient completion of the assembly process in a high quality and repeatable manner
- Operate machine to assemble dip tubes to a pump actuator.
- Place reel of plastic tubing onto spindle and that feeds tubing into machine.
- Load Actuators into elevator that feeds bowl feeder.
- Remove filled boxes from machine , seal, label and palletize.
- Replace dull unusable blades
- Perform duties to complete a wide variety of complicated machine set ups such as assembly adjustments, mechanical parts change
- Perform quality checks/audits during a production run through visual inspection and aligned with the quality plan
- Measure, examine and test assembly units to detect malfunctions or out of tolerance conditions.
- Adjust machine to correct faulty operation.
- Perform preventive maintenance on Assembly machines to maintain production equipment and reduce downtime. Identify efficiency improvement, cost savings and quality improvement opportunities.
- Assist with CI activities as needed: root cause analysis and corrective actions
- Maintain accurate documentation of quality inspection results and production results
